Gifted

The apostle Paul speaks of the church as the body of Christ. It may be the best-known metaphor in all of Scripture. It speaks of the unity of the spiritual body made up of the disciples of Jesus. It reminds us that no person–no pastor, no administrator, no pope or potentate–is the head of the church. Only *Jesus* is the head of the church.

And it speaks to one other reality: every single member has a role to play in the life of the body. After all, in a healthy body, every member contributes to the entire body's well-being. *Spiritual gifts* is the name given to these special abilities each member possesses. And *every* member of the body of Christ has a spiritual gift or spiritual gift mix.

This series addresses five questions: What <u>are</u> spiritual gifts? Why are they necessary? What spiritual gifts does the Bible identify? What do I do with my spiritual gift(s)? And, How do I discover what spiritual gifts(s) I have?

The Quilters are canceling their meeting this Sunday January 23 due to Covid but will resume their monthly meeting in February. Sorry for the inconvenience.


