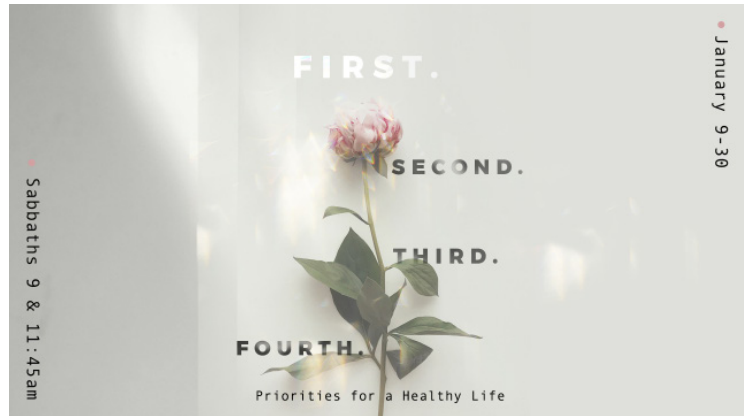

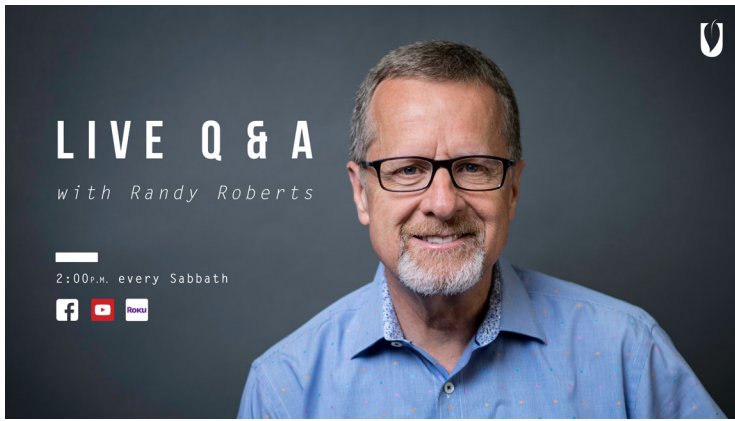

Black History Celebration: The Loma Linda University Church will celebrate Black History on February 6. Our guest speaker will be Chaplain Barry Black, chaplain of the U.S. Senate. We'll also have world-class musicians sharing American Negro Spirituals and Christian songs that inspired the civil rights movement.

February Sermon Series: *The Abiding Disciple*: We all desire to live fruitful, productive lives. We want our lives to matter, to make a difference for good in the world. But how are we to do so? On the last night before his crucifixion, Jesus spent intimate moments opening his heart to his disciples.
