We teach inner-city youth the great music of the world, and provide opportunities for them to perform that music in the most magnificent settings of our community.

Charles (Chuck) Dickerson is the executive director and conductor of the Inner City Youth Orchestra of Los Angeles. He has directed performances of many of the greatest orchestral and choral works throughout the United States, Europe, and Asia.

He is an alumnus of La Sierra University where he was a music major. He then earned a Bachelor of Science in psychology from Howard University. He also holds a Juris Doctor from American University in Washington, D.C., and a Master of Music from California State University, Los Angeles, in conducting and African American music.
