**Baptisms**



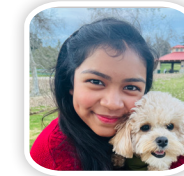

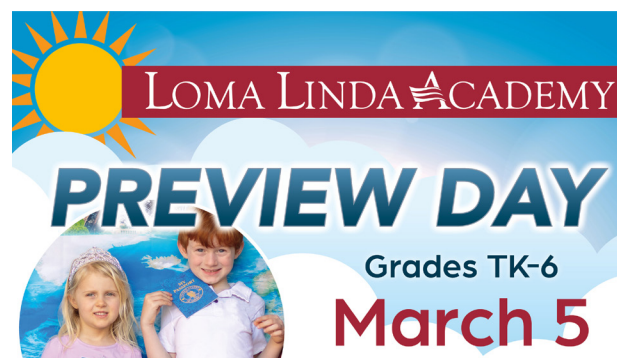
