A Message from your Pastoral Team

Dear church family,

Loma Linda University Church (LLUC) pastors and leaders have spent much time sorting through the situation that currently exists in the world because of COVID-19. We have consulted with scientists and clinicians; listened closely to church leadership; and carefully taken into account what government leaders are saying. Throughout this process, we have kept our LLUC community foremost in our minds and hearts. Finally, and most important of all, we have prayed, asking God for wisdom, guidance and care.

As a result of this process, we have made the decision to suspend worship services and Sabbath School programs this Sabbath. We will take future weeks on a week-to-week basis, fully understanding that the potential for this suspension to last longer is high. We do this out of concern for the health and well-being of our community, out of solidarity with our healthcare professionals and their attempts to contain the spread of the virus, and from a desire to participate fully with the leadership of our larger church.

We will broadcast worship services and Sanctuary Sabbath School at their normally-scheduled times. We encourage you to join us via the broadcast.

During this time, **all meetings and programs of the church are being suspended.** We will keep you updated as the situation continues to unfold. The best place to get such updates will be on our church website: <http://www.lluc.org>. Besides updates as the situation changes, the website will also offer a weekly flow of information that will keep you informed as to the status of weekly worship services and Sabbath schools.

As a leadership team, we are here to serve our beloved church community. In particular, if you are in one of the at-risk groups (older adults, persons with medical conditions such as heart disease, diabetes, lung disease, etc.) and need service such as rides to doctor appointments or Meals-on-Wheels, please inform us by calling (909) 796-8357. Again, we are here to serve you.

Our pastoral and support staff will continue to be present and available at the church office unless the situation requires such to change.

May God bless you and may God bless all those who are working hard to protect so many.
