Message from the Pastors

Dear Church Family,

In just one short week, our lives have dramatically changed. Activities and practices that we used to take for granted are no longer available to us. In particular, we have missed the in-person connections with all of you.

However, despite the challenges it causes, we are committed to standing with other churches, community groups, and LLUH to slow the spread of COVID-19 and protect the most vulnerable members of society. Accordingly, we have discontinued all in-person gatherings at our church for the foreseeable future. We will let you know when that changes. Also, our Church Office is closed until further notice. However, please call us if you need assistance (909) 558-4570. Our visitation pastors are available to perform phone call visitations, and our pastors will be holding their regular office hours by phone. We know that COVID-19 presents immense challenges for many members of our community. We encourage our church family to reach out; this is not the time to be shy.

Despite these changes, our church remains active in ministry. We continue our commitment to support each other in our discipleship journey. Our staff and ministry leaders are excited to provide new ways to participate in worship, study, prayer, community, and care for one another. We will share them with you in the coming weeks.

Though the challenges that we face are significant, we also have the opportunity to come together and care for each other and our neighbors. Three ways come to mind. First, pray for the safety of the most vulnerable members of our community and our frontline health workers. Second, reach out by phone, text, or email to someone who may be feeling isolated. Third, if you are available and are not a part of the vulnerable population, volunteer to deliver groceries or meals to those who are. And of course, fight the spread of this disease by practicing good hygiene, avoiding crowded areas as much as possible, and observing healthy social buffering (at least six feet) when you are with people who are not a part of your immediate household.

May God's peace, which surpasses understanding, be with you all.
