Even beyond remembering the scenes of a movie, we tend to remember its soundtrack. A movie's soundtrack becomes the music of its story. One can listen to the soundtrack later—even having forgotten most of the movie's scenes—and become emotionally immersed in the ethos of the movie.

The psalms were the soundtracks of Israel's life. They capture the full spectrum of human spiritual and emotional life—praise and rage, worship and wrath, questions and answers, unfulfilled hopes and unrealized dreams.
