## Child Dedication & Baptisms



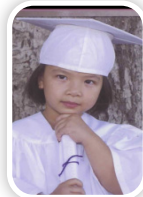
**Aisla Lannae Corona** was born January 26. She is the daughter of Annette and Luis Corona. Annette is

for Christ. She feels his love and knows she has been changed in so many different ways when she puts her life in God's hands.



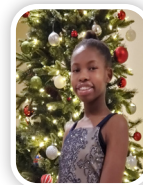
**Nhi Chau** likes to cook with friends and family. She chose to be baptized to be closer to God and celebrate his
