Remedial Going Back to the Basics

Famed American pastor Brennan Manning once wrote: "When I get honest, I admit that I am a bundle of paradoxes." This simple statement could be used to describe most of us: beautiful and broken, self-assured and sheepish, optimistic and apathetic. Indeed, we are a bundle of contradictions, but so is this wondrous faith we call Christianity, one in which the first are the last, finding life means losing it, leading is synonymous with serving, and Jesus is both human and divine. This summer we return to the basics, not to untangle paradoxes but to become comfortable with them.
