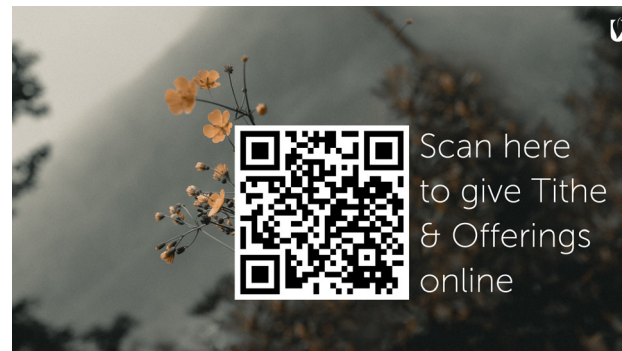
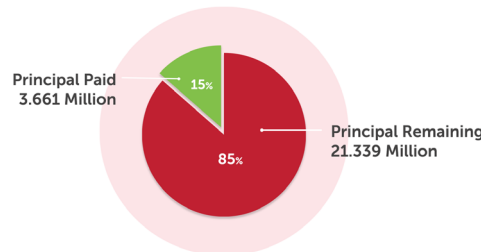

Famed American pastor Brennan Manning once wrote: "When I get honest, I admit that I am a bundle of paradoxes." This simple statement could be used to describe most of us: beautiful and broken, self-assured and sheepish, optimistic and apathetic.
