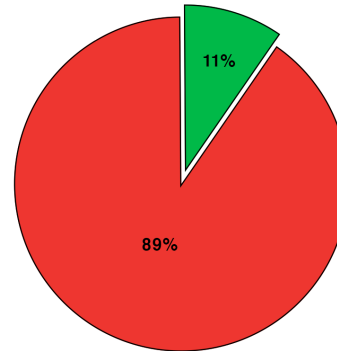

To BELieve or Not To BELieve—THAT is The Question

The question is penetrating: “Do you believe in God?” Depending on the answer, the next question quickly follows: “How can you believe in God?” Such questions can be asked in disbelief or curiosity, in anger or openness. Sometimes others ask it of us; sometimes we ask it of them. This camp meeting, we ask it of you.

Who is *you*?

Anyone who joins, views, or listens, but especially two groups: Those who are curious, who doubt, who would *like* to believe but who—sometimes for very good reasons—just can’t. And those who are skeptical—but remain open enough to at least consider the possibility of belief.

Might there be a belief—a *faith*—that is both robust and humble, convinced but kind, assured but respectful? And if so, what is the foundation of such faith?

It could be that at this juncture in history, *To Believe or Not to Believe—THAT is the Question.*
