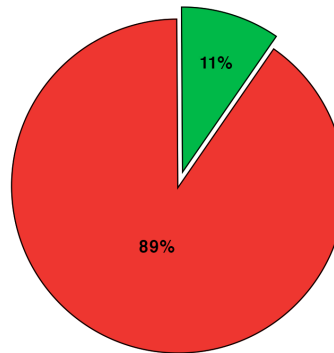

Might there be a belief—a faith—that is both robust and humble, convinced but kind, assured but respectful? And if so, what is the foundation of such faith?

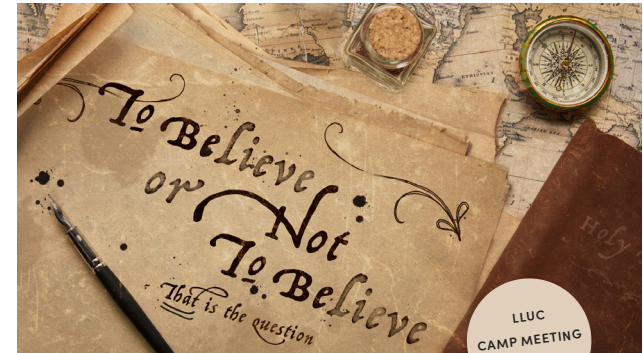
It could be that at this juncture in history, *To Believe or Not to Believe—THAT is The Question.*
