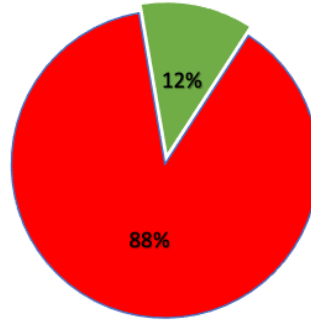

Child Dedication & Baptisms



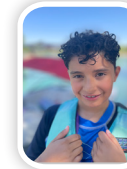
