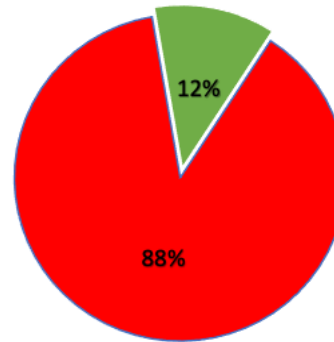

Twice awarded the Bronze Star Medal for actions on Guam and in the Philippines, Doss further distinguished himself in the Battle of Okinawa by saving 75 wounded men. He was the only conscientious objector to receive the Medal of Honor for his actions during this war. The film will begin at 5 p.m. in the Sanctuary. Following the movie, representatives from the Desmond Doss Foundation will host a Q and A. The screening is free; an offering will be taken.
