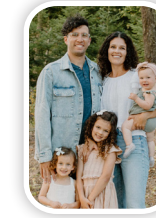

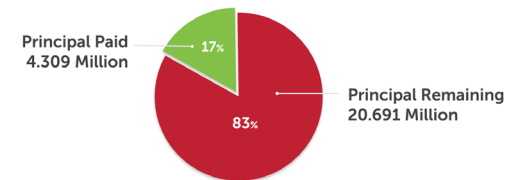
Child Dedication

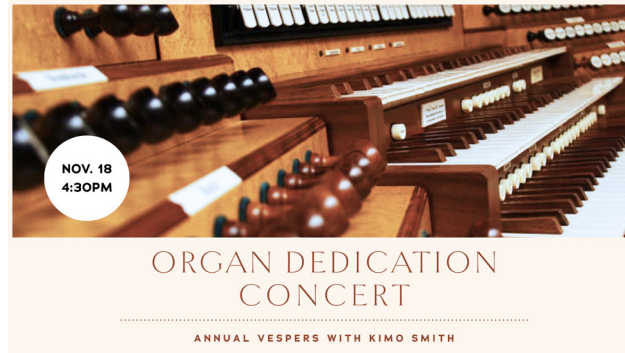
