Since the beginning of this decade, our world has experienced significant and rapid changes. The global pandemic, economic instability, and ongoing discussions about important social issues such as race, gender, and sexuality have permanently altered our lives. As we navigate these shifts, many Christians are asking "How do I engage with this constantly changing culture?"

This question has been asked throughout history, and it is one that Jesus himself addressed in his final prayer before his crucifixion. Despite facing unimaginable torment, Jesus spent his final moments interceding for his disciples, knowing that the changes to come would bring uncertainty and doubt.
