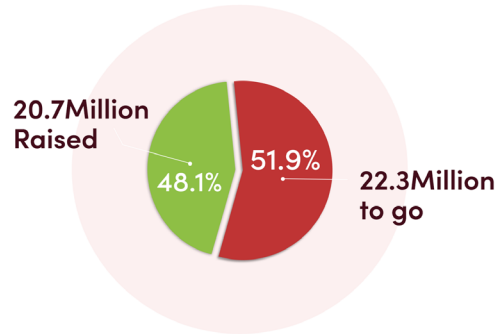

Unprofessional

God's Design for Ministry

Church history bears witness to various shifts that have taken place over the last two thousand years. This means that significant differences exist between the early church which Jesus established and which the apostles led and the current realities of the 21st-century Christian church. One key shift is the move from lay ministry, in which unprofessional people led, to a church dominated by professionals. Yet a church where professionals minister and where lay people consume is anything but the church Jesus founded.

What caused such a shift? How should we relate to it today? And, most important of all, how can we recover an unprofessional church reflective of God's design for ministry?

Increasing evidence shows that vaccinated individuals can spread the new variant even when they are asymptomatic. Because the number of cases is impacting our hospital systems, based on the guidance of medical professionals and the SECC, we strongly recommend that everyone wear a mask at indoor church gatherings regardless of vaccination status until further notice.
