**The Great Exchange Sermon Series:** The incarnation of Jesus is “The Great Exchange.” When, in Christ, God wrapped himself in human flesh, God traded places with us. How recently have you paused to consider just what that means? These words might help: “Christ was treated as we deserve, that we might be treated as He deserves. He was condemned for our sins, in which He had no share, that we might be justified by His righteousness, in which we had no share. He suffered the death which was ours, that we might receive the life which was His” (Ellen G. White, *The Desire of Ages*, p. 25). Advent is the time when we turn our focus to such thoughts—thoughts almost too grand to grasp. But just specifically how does this great exchange affect us? What exactly does Jesus offer to give us? And, when we’ve received what he offers, what is expected of us? Join our study of *The Great Exchange* November 28 through December 26.
