



The more time I spend contemplating the Baby in the manger, the more multi-faceted becomes the reality of what happened there. There are so many messages that emanate from that manger. The God of the universe took on flesh and came to earth. God (in the words of Eugene Peterson) moved into the neighborhood. God is "with us." God comes to us in weakness, not in power. God is vulnerable to all the pain and heartache that we experience. And the list could go on. And on. There is just so much that happened on that long ago night when heaven came close. It is But then, when you receive God's forgivenessas you bask in the peace that comes from being reconciled to God-remember this: the discipleship journey with Jesus is based on regifting-not regifting the gifts that we don't want, but regifting the very best gifts we've ever received! With that in mind, forgiveness is a gift that we have to regift. If we wish to truly experience it and enjoy it, we have to regift it. To not regift it is to lose it.

So, some questions . . . Who needs to know of your forgiveness? What person in your life needs to hear you say, "I forgive you?" Against whom have you harbored ill will? Whose "debt" do you need to cancel? And then, Will you make that choice and deliver that message today? Will you take the gift of forgiveness God has given you and regift it?

Jesus said, "Freely you have received, freely give." Will you do that with the forgiveness God has given you?
