

The Five Prayers of Advent

Joining the Dialogue of Eternity

Advent (Christmas in the vernacular) is all about carols and heralds, bells and bows, sleigh bells, and snowbanks. It's about trinkets and trees, about Santa Claus and shopping, about giving and getting–mostly getting. It's about these and other similar things. Right?

Or is it?

What if Advent is actually about something far grander than that? What if Advent is about joining the dialogue of eternity, the conversation (as Eugene Peterson puts it) that takes place around the very throne of God? And what if the way we are able to join that conversation is through the simple act of prayer?

Luke's gospel records five Advent prayers, traditionally known, in Christian circles, by their first words as they appeared in the Latin Vulgate translation of the Bible. Each of those prayers draws us into the dialogue unfolding between heaven and earth.

Won't you humble your heart, bow your head, close your eyes, and join the eternal conversation?


Typhoid Mary: LLU School of Religion Humanities program will
